This is why every time one of our actors enters a classroom, one of the first things they do is hand the teacher an evaluation for our visit that day. We want each and every teacher to know that we not only value their feedback, but we crave it. It is the only way for us to know the impact we are having, and where we can improve our program to better meet the needs of our partner schools.

Actively seeking feedback is how our entire Sequential Dramatics Programming began. Back in the early 1970's, the leaders of our organization at that time went directly to teachers and school administrators and asked them, "what would be most impactful for you and your students from a visiting theatre program?" The resounding response was that the one-show-fits-all, assembly-style performances were not ideal. They wanted a show that would not only support their particular curriculum at each grade level, but that would also meet students where they are developmentally and in turn, something they will find true entertainment value in.

Those discussions planted the seeds for what would eventually become the framework for our Sequential Dramatics Program. This program is unlike any other in the country. Our pre-performance classroom workshops ensure that students are making cross-connections from our show to their curriculum, and that they have a complete understanding of the world of the play before viewing the production. Then the students experience a production that has been carefully crafted with their specific needs in mind to not only educate, but to inspire and spark change.

We hope you and your students continue to find deep satisfaction in the programming we offer, and know that we welcome your feedback at any time. As always, we thank you for your continued commitment to the arts and look forward to our continued partnership!


